I. CALL TO ORDER

Roll call: Dr. Byrne 8:30 am.

II. INITIAL INVESTIGATIVE REVIEW AND ACTION ON THE FOLLOWING CASES

1. 24-106, In Re: Jorge Pineiro, DVM

After discussion and consideration, a motion was made by Dr. Thompson and seconded by Ms. Soloman to accept the Investigative Committee's recommendations and offer Dr. Pineiro a **Consent Agreement**, adopting the Investigative Committee's Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as the Board's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, which includes the following:

A.R.S. 32-2232 § (11) *Gross negligence: Misdiagnosis of the cat which caused unnecessary suffering and subsequent death; based on the elevated blood glucose and glucose in the urine, Respondent should have recommended hospitalization for further diagnostics and treatment or offered referral to another premises for care within the next 24 hours.*

A.R.S. 32-2232 § (12) *as it relates to A.A.C. R3-11-501 (1) failure to provide professionally acceptable procedures for instructing the pet owner to research the cat's symptoms online.*

A.R.S. 32-2232 § (21) *as it relates to A.A.C. R3-11-502 (L) (5) failure to document in the cat's medical record the animal's tentative or definitive diagnosis with respect to the urinary tract infection, elevated glucose and glucose in the urine.*

Motion passed unanimously.

After further discussion and consideration, a motion was made by Dr. Thompson and seconded by Dr. Nausley to offer Dr. Pineiro a Consent Agreement that includes a period of **Probation for 1-year** to obtain an additional **four (4) hours of continuing education** in addition to the statutory requirements to maintain licensure. Those four hours shall be in **diabetes**. Additionally, the Consent Agreement shall include **reimbursement of fees** to the pet owner for veterinary services provided by Dr. Pineiro. If the Consent Agreement is not signed in 30 days, the matter shall be scheduled for an Informal Interview. Motion passed unanimously.

After discussion and consideration, a motion was made by Dr. Wright and seconded by Dr. Nausley to accept the Investigative Committee's recommendation and **dismiss** this issue with no violation. Motion passed unanimously.

This matter will be pended until the next Board meeting for further review. Motion passed 5 ayes, 1 nay (Ms. Soloman).

A.R.S. § 32-2232 (21) Failure to maintain adequate records of services provided by not documenting critical information regarding client conversations.
